Fire Fighters visit local Daycare

A child's first sight of a firefighter should not come in an emergency situation, such as a fire at their home. Volusia County Fire Services– Lake Helen Station took the opportunity on October 3rd, to visit a local daycare to familiarize children with firemen and their duties.

Children at A Beautiful Day Daycare were taught what to do in the event of a fire, and enjoyed practicing the "Stop, Drop and Roll" technique. Lt. Huber also dressed in his full firefighting gear to familiarize children with the sometimes scary appearance of firemen ready for battle.

The Fire Team stressed that, in the event of a fire, they not be scared and showed them how a firefighter might sound speaking with his air tank running.

The children were then treated to a tour of the fire trucks complete with junior firefighter hats. The children were given an opportunity to ask the men questions and even help with the fire hose.
